EXPLORE TUCUMCARI'S FOUR ICONIC MUSEUMS:

Tucumcari Historical Museum · 416 S. ADAMS ST.

Collections located on three floors of the 1903 schoolhouse, containing a wide variety of artifacts and memorabilia from the surrounding area. Various rooms are based on themes with thousands of items on display.

New Mexico Route 66 Museum - 1500 W. ROUTE 66 BLVD.

Alook into the Land of Enchantment's Route 66 heritage. From Glenrio to Gallup, the Ozark Trails system to today's Historic Route 66 and everything in between.

Mesalands Dinosaur Museum · 222 E. LAUGHLIN AVE.

Replicated and original fossils from tiny footprint casts to the 40' long skeleton Torvosaurus. The Museum's focus is on the Mesozoic period, which is also known as 'The Age of Dinosaurs.'

Tucumcari Railroad Museum - 100 W. RAILROAD AVE.

Exhibits in the restored Union Station depot originally built in 1926. Explore the many historical aspects of the railroad industry in Eastern New Mexico from the 19th Century to the present day.
